### **Measure H must have 2/3 of the vote to go into effect.**

A 2/3 vote was required because the City Council restricted the use of the proceeds of the proposed tax to reducing sewer use charges. That made the tax a "special tax" under California Constitution Article XIIC, Section 1(d): "Special tax" means any tax imposed for specific purposes, including a tax imposed for specific purposes which is placed into a general fund." A 2/3 vote is required for cities to impose a special tax. See California Constitution Article XIII A, Section 4.
