

## INVITATION TO BID

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received at the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Colfax, 33 South Main Street, P.O. Box 702 Colfax, CA 95713 **until 2:00 p.m. on November 1, 2017** at which time they will be publicly open and read for the construction in accordance with the project plans and specifications for the following public works project:

The project consists of the construction of an earthen levee with a shotcrete surface across an existing shotcrete lined wastewater pond. The construction, in general, includes excavation, embankment, removal of existing shotcrete liner, HDPE pipes and fittings, gate valve assemblies, concrete headwalls, placement of shotcrete liner, concrete pedestals supports and various other items of work.

Bids will be opened and tabulated by or on behalf of the City Clerk immediately after 2:00 o'clock p.m. on **November 1, 2017**. Any bids received after the time specified shall be return unopened. Said bids will be reviewed and referred to the Colfax City Council for consideration.

Project Location: The work is located at the existing City of Colfax WWTP, approximately 1.6 miles southeast of the central city at 23550 Grandview Avenue, Colfax, CA 95713.

Bidders shall familiarize themselves with the site prior to preparing their bids. Arrangements for access to the site must be made by contacting the City’s Project Manager. Bids are required for the entire work described herein. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids, and to waive any irregularities in said bids.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Questions must be submitted in writing as soon as reasonably possible, but no later than three (3) working days before the date specified for bid opening and may referred to:

Please note that questions received less than three (3) working days before the time specified for opening bids may not be answered. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

The Engineer's Estimate of probable construction cost of the project is \$160,000.

The City will hold a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting scheduled for 2:00 p.m. on October 26, 2017, at the site at 23550 Grandview Avenue, Colfax, CA 95713.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribe forms and accompanied by cash, a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form payable to the City in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid. Bidders are responsible to confirm receipt of addenda and City responses to questions from Bidders.

The successful bidders will be required to furnish a payment bond and faithful performance bond each in the full amount of the contract price, and insurance with certificates and endorsements of insurance as provided in the contract documents. The required bonds must be provided only by a surety insurance who is admitted to do business by and in good standing with the California Department of Insurance.

Bidders are hereby notified in accordance with Public Contract Code Section 22300, securities may be substituted for any monies that the City may withhold pursuant to the terms of this Contract to ensure performance.

The successful bidder must possess the following classification or type of contractor's license issued by the Contractor State License Board: Class "A", California.

To be qualified to bid on this Project, bidders must be registered and qualified to perform public work with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. All subcontractors listed in a qualified bidder's bid as performing any portion of the work also must be registered and qualified with the Department of Industrial Relations.


All of the work for this contract shall be substantially completed within **30 working days** from the date specified in the City's Notice to Proceed, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. The City will assess liquidated damages in the amount of **\$700 per each working day**, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement. The successful Bidder will be required to submit baseline and progress schedules, in a format and manner acceptable to the City of Colfax, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

The attention of bidders is directed to the requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and prevailing wage rates to be paid to all workers employed under the Contract in accordance with Labor Code sections 1770 and following. Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the City's office, and will be made available to any interested party on request. In accordance with Labor Code section 1771.4(a)(1), this project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The City reserves the right to reject all bids. Any bid not conforming to the intent and purpose of the Contract Documents may be rejected. The City may extend the time to award the Contract.
